This eleven-part harmony will make every show fresh, fun and exciting. From die-hard a cappella aficionados to even the most sceptical of Fringe visitors, this show will charm and entertain everybody who comes along.

The Oxford Alternotives are **Oxford University's** longest established a cappella group, formed in 1993 as an alternative to the chapel choirs that dominated the university's singing scene at the time. Since then, the group established themselves as Oxford's premier mixed a cappella group, well known for their unique take on famous hits, irresistible on-stage fun and signature splash of purple. During our last Fringe run they were invited to sing on BBC Radio's Mark Forrest Show and accompanied a proposal during one of their live performances, they even sang at their wedding last month! In addition to their Edinburgh Festival Fringe performances, the group tour regularly and have recently returned from a whirlwind trip to the USA's east coast performing with some of the top collegiate a cappella groups in the world, they have also just released their newest EP featuring arrangements of David Bowie, Disclosure, Queen and a Disco Mashup!
