Gone Rogue Productions The Pitchfork Disney by Philip Ridley

The Pitchfork Disney is a quintessential In-Yer-Face play written by Philip Ridley in 1991 and still astoundingly relevant with it's portrayal of intense fear and paranoia of contemporary culture and life. **The Pitchfork Disney** has been shocking and revolting audience members alike for over 20 years. In 2017, the play remains a visual and psychological spectacle, a sensational piece of theatre challenging and manipulating the audience from beginning to end.

Presented in real-time, Presley and Haley Stray are orphaned and perpetually infantilised 28 year-olds, unable to leave their East London flat since their parents death ten years prior. They survive on chocolate, barbiturates and stories they tell one another to escape their anxieties of ordinary life. Ridley's language is immersive, subversively beautiful and stacked with imagery, allowing Haley and Presley to create whole worlds through their stories. Their stories conjure Cosmo Disney, a perfect boy in a red jacket made of sweet wrappers, who promises Presley – numbed by nihilistic oblivion – an escape and a new life. Cosmo is joined by his partner Pitchfork Cavalier to perform a show for the twins. What happens when you can't tell the difference between dream and reality?

Founded in 2012 for that year's Edinburgh Fringe, **Gone Rogue** returns for the sixth successive year, buoyed by recent success. The Company's scope has always been broad, encompassing theatre, musicals, and comedy and is presenting five shows, including *Like Dolphins Can Swim*, at this year's Fringe — making a total of 17 productions since inception.
