But while Captain Hero-Man and The Mighty Hedgehog appear not to have changed beyond the necessary accumulation of a few extra superpowers, their friendship has lost its childhood innocence. Recent years have brought grief and secrets, and though they have both been happy to accept denial and hide behind their masks, the masks are slipping and it is becoming impossible to keep these darker issues at bay.

This new, bitter-sweet play explores the challenges many friendships must face with dry wit and brittle honesty. Making peace with ourselves is never easy, but how else can we move on?

Founded in 2012 for that year's Edinburgh Fringe, Gone Rogue returns for the sixth successive year, buoyed by recent success. The company's scope has always been broad, encompassing theatre, musicals, and comedy and is presenting five shows, including Philip Ridley's The Pitchfork Disney, at this year's Fringe making a total of 17 productions since inception.
