The Lincoln Company marks anniversary of Simon Stephens' masterpiece Pornography

Simon Stephens' Pornography is set across the first seven days of July in 2005, offering a kaleidoscopic view of a London that moved from the euphoria of Live 8 and the Olympics announcement, to the devastation of the July 7 bombings. The play is composed of eight stories that serve as a countdown to the catastrophic event in London. Each playlet focuses on a different individual dramatising their life in the run-up to the tragedy.

Since 2008, **The Lincoln Company** has brought the best student and graduate work from the **University of Lincoln** to the Edinburgh Fringe and this year, the Lincoln Company is bringing another exciting and varied company to the world's biggest arts festival. In previous years, The Lincoln Company has produced sell out musicals *Sweeney Todd* (2012), *The Addams Family* (2014), and award-winning work devised from graduate companies like **Flickbook Theatre** and **Egg Box Theatre Company**. The company is now producing the tenth anniversary production of **Simon Stephens' Pornography**, and brand new devised theatre from some of Lincolnshire's most promising emerging companies.

Directors **James Ashfield** and **Simon Panayi** return to the Edinburgh Fringe after appearing as performers last year in **The Lincoln Company**'s *Company*, and **Push to Shove Theatre**'s *Dracula*. Feeling privileged to tackle Simon Stephens' play, especially in the current climate, they explore the complex role of the terrorist, and ask what it was that allowed someone to reach such a point of desperation and hate to commit such a heinous act. It is this question that they believe Stephens' play can still address 10 years on as we face a more divided society and an ever-present threat of terror.
